Objectives

- iii. To make the students understand the difference between STIs and HIV/AIDS
- iv. To reduce new occurrence of HIV infection among the youth by highlighting the risk perception through awareness on HIV prevention methods
- v. To induce the spirit among the youth to help and support people living with HIV/AIDS (PLWHA) and thereby reduce the stigma and discrimination against PLWHA.
- vi. To encourage the members for voluntary blood donation.
- vii. To encourage Peer Education.
